



Sandy Cape Recreation Park

Bookings are required for camping anywhere in the Sandy Cape Recreation Park reserve.

Unlicensed off-road vehicles are prohibited throughout the reserve.

General waste bins and waste water dump points are located at the information bay at the entry to the reserve.

North and South 4x4 Only Camping Areas

- Campers must have a self-contained chemical toilet.
- Campers must take all rubbish and human waste out of the reserve and dispose of responsibly.
- Track conditions change regularly. 4x4 required at all times.

Respect the Fragile Coastal Environment

- Always lower tyre pressures before driving on the beaches and tracks.
- Do not drive over vegetation or remove vegetation.
- Do not create your own track.

Campfires

- Permitted 1 April – 31 October (excluding Easter long weekend).
- Must be contained in an enclosure and controlled at all times.
- Are NOT permitted when the Fire Danger Rating for the Lesueur District is "HIGH" or above, during a Total Fire Ban, or when instructed by a Fire Control Officer.
- Are NOT permitted on the beach or in any access way throughout the reserve.

Respect Other Campers

- Quiet time from 10 pm.
- Dogs must be on a lead at all times and all waste must be disposed of responsibly.
- Generators are allowed between 8 am and 8 pm only.
