

Coastal Escape Without the Big Drive

Just two and a half hours north of Perth, Jurien Bay delivers the kind of holiday that feels both effortless and unforgettable. Protected turquoise waters, marine wildlife encounters, national park adventures, and relaxed coastal dining combine to create a destination designed for connection.

This three-day itinerary is tailored for couples, young adventurers, or a weekend away with friends, balancing activity with downtime.

Pack your bags and beach towels it's time to explore Jurien Bay in three days.



Approximately 219km from Perth CBD

Day 01

Enjoy your journey to Jurien Bay along the breathtaking Indian Ocean Drive.

Grab a bite to eat from the Jurien Bay Bakery

Morning - MOUNT LESUEUR NATIONAL PARK

Arrive in Jurien Bay early morning and set off for Mount Lesueur National Park.

Mount Lesueur National Park

Head out on a self-drive loop trail through Mount Lesueur National Park, known for its rich biodiversity and wildflower displays (in season).

Take the time to explore fascinating natural attractions including salt lakes, coastal dunes, Mount Lesueur and Mount Michaud.

Lunch

Enjoy a relaxed late lunch and a cold beverage at Kakka Alley — a great spot to recharge before an active afternoon.

Afternoon – Sandy Cape Recreation Park

Cool off with a refreshing swim at Sandy Cape, just north of Jurien Bay.


Spend the afternoon sandboarding down the dunes, snorkelling in the clear shallow waters, paddleboarding, and exploring the area's abundant marine life.

Evening

Head back into town and unwind with a sunset dinner at the Jurien Bay Beach Café, overlooking the water. Great photo opportunity for sunset at the café or on the jetty.





Day 02

Early Morning – Jurien Bay Marine Park Tour (3–5 hours)

Embark on a one-of-a-kind tour through the Jurien Bay Marine Park.

Swim with playful Australian sea lions — known as the “puppies of the sea” and snorkel vibrant reefs rich in colourful fish and coral.

Optional: Prefer to stay dry? You can skip the swims and experience the entire adventure from the comfort of the boat — perfect for non-swimmers and all ages.

Lunch

Enjoy classic fish and chips on the foreshore (takeaway from Jurien Seafoods) while relaxing on the wide grassed areas, nature playground, skate park, jetty, and sheltered beach.

After lunch, take a slow stroll, grab an ice cream, or simply soak up the coastal atmosphere. We recommend exploring the town and local shops.

Late Afternoon (Optional)

Take a drive to Hill River, enjoy the views from Molah Lookout, and go fishing either at the beach or in Hill River. It's also a great spot for a dip and birdwatching Or

4x4 north of the marina and enjoy the clear ocean with a chance to swim with dolphins.

Dinner

Grab some fresh produce from the local IGA and enjoy a relaxed BBQ picnic on the foreshore or at Sandy Cape for a beachside cook-up and watch the sunset over the water.

Day 03

Morning – Skydiving Thrill

If you're feeling adventurous, take the leap with Skydive Jurien Bay, famous for its unmatched coastal views and soft beach landings. A true bucket-list moment.

Season & Weather

This itinerary is a flexible guide and can be adjusted depending on the weather, as some activities or attractions may not be operating at certain times, so it's always best to check before booking. The most enjoyable weather in the region is typically during autumn and spring, when days are warm but not too hot and lighter winds are common.

Wildflower season usually begins in July and can continue through to October, offering a colourful backdrop for outdoor adventures. Activities can easily be moved around to make the most of the conditions during your visit.
